Miss Agnes E. Morine went out to India in September 1920 from Bunnythorpe, being commended by the assembly there and also by Pohangina, Cambridge and Ohingaiti. She engaged in language study at Kumbanadu and Trichur and then joined Mr and Mrs J.M. Davies at Parur visiting the womenfolk in the villages round about. One [sic] January 3rd 1922,

she was married to Mr George Black and they made their home at Irinjalakuda.
