



Miss M. Reeve – 1898 (Edition 1)

Miss M. Reeve was commended by Palmerston North and went out to Malaya as one of the group that left New Zealand in October 1898. She was not a young woman at that time and after four years at Penang she returned home in poor health. Subsequently she worked amongst the Maori people in the Te Kuiti area for a number of years later retiring to New Plymouth where she died in February 1942, aged 95 years.
