I HAVE the honor, by direction of the Commander-in-Chief, to request that it may be ascertained from the home authorities whether the pensioners named in the accompanying list, who are in the receipt of the annuity for meritorious service, are still living and drawing their annuities. Should any casualty have occurred, I am to ask that it may be communicated early to this office with the date on which it took place.

I am also to request that, in order to admit of selections for the annuity being made on vacancies occurring from among the applicants for the same already registered, it may be ascertained if the pensioners, who are also named in the list, are still living and residing at the places noted against their names.
