I then served in the 3rd European (Bengals) under Colonel Ridle [Ridell] at Agra engagement at Susca on the 5th July 1857 under Brigder [Brigadier] Polwel and Colonel Ridle [Riddell] likewise at Alygur on the 24th August 1857 with Major Montgomery. At Agra on the 10th October 1857 with Colonel Greethead's [Greathed's] Coloum [Column] and with Bridgier [Brigadier] Cotton scouring all round the district at Cyperia at the execution of Tannitropa.
