

Miss C.R. Newport - 1904 (Edition 1)

Miss Cora R. Newport went out to India in October 1904 from Upper Motupiko, Nelson. She made her home with Mr and Mrs Beer from England and studied the Telugu language. She took the opportunity of speaking to her language teacher about the Lord. In 1906 after passing her examination in Telugu she went out visiting on the house-boat but became ill shortly afterwards and died of typhoid fever with complications on January 6th, 1907.
