

## Mr A.E. Roxburgh - 1908 (Edition 1)

Mr Alfred E. Roxburgh went out to India in November 1908 travelling via U.K. He spent some time in Daddi in 1910 and then joined Mr and Mrs Storrie at Chandgad. In 1911 he helped Mr Henderson at Khanapur and Dr Hunter at Belgaum during which visits he was learning the Marathi language. In 1912 he engaged in visiting fairs and villages, camping out and distributing Scriptures and literature with brethren de Carteret and Henderson. In August of that year he returned to New Zealand to attend to matters at home and remained there.
