Mr Charles J. Rolls went out to India from Napier in August 1910. He joined Mr Witty at Colombo, Ceylon and helped in the work there for some nine months. In 1911 he moved to Coimbatore to relieve Mr Handley Bird and for the following ten years itinerated in the Travancore (Kerala) District. During their furloughs he relieved the Noels at Kumbanadu in 1912-13 and 1918-20, maintaining the different aspects of their work. He enjoyed a profitable ministry at conferences throughout the whole district as well as conducting a special series of meetings in many places. He returned to New Zealand in 1921.
