

Miss M.E. Davies - 1898 (Edition 1)

Commended by the assembly at Palmerston North in 1898, Miss M.E. Davies went out to Malaya in October of that year as one of a group of five missionaries accompanying Mr Wm McDonald to Penang. She worked there amongst women and children for four years before returning to New Zealand in March 1903 because of ill health. She settled in Wellington and engaged in the nursing profession until she died suddenly on July 14th 1930.
