

Mr H.H. Burns - 1914 (Edition 1)

Mr H.H. Burns, who was commended by the assembly at Hastings, went out to Singapore in September 1914 with the express purpose of helping in the English speaking work for six months. He found ample opportunities of witnessing amongst the soldiers, sailors and English speaking residents working in fellowship with the assembly in the city of Singapore. He returned to New Zealand after nine months, and subsequently he helped in preaching to the soldiers in the Trentham Military Camp. He died in Hastings in July, 1955, aged 79.
