

## **Mr J.J. Burns - 1932 (Edition 1)**

Mr John J. Burns, whose commendation by Nelson Street assembly, Hastings, had been endorsed by the Eden Hall assembly, Auckland, left for Malaya in February 1932. He proceeded to Kuala Lumpur where he was warmly welcomed by the missionaries met together for the Easter Conference. Though he had considered going to India to study Tamil he was hindered from doing so and instead engaged in language study while helping with Mr Angus and his son David from U.K. at Kuala Lumpur. He was married to Miss Doris Mercer at Kuala Lumpur on August 12th, 1932, and later returned to New Zealand.
